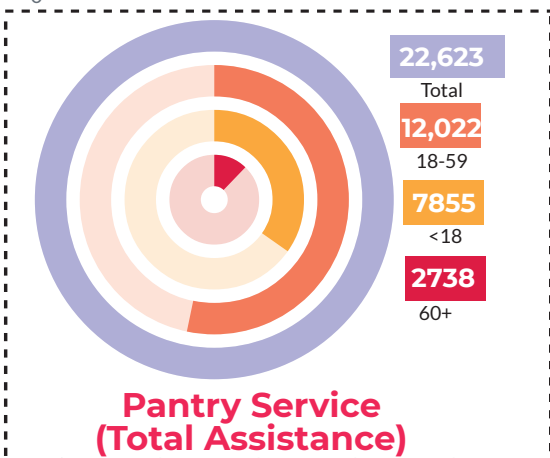
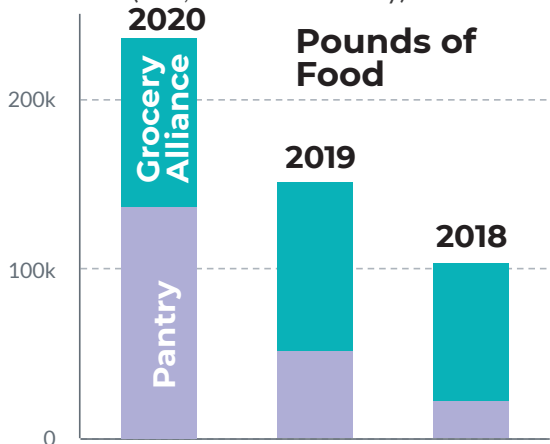

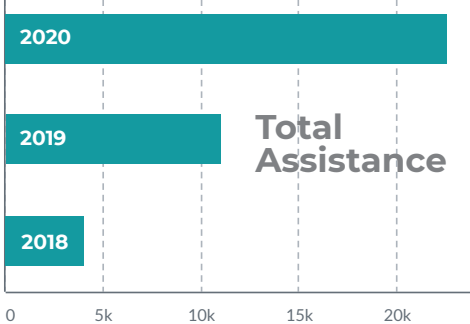
WHAT'S BEEN HAPPENING IN THE NEIGHBORHOOD?

FIGHTING HUNGER

We provide food for those experiencing a food emergency (Pantry) and for those struggling with longer term food instability (Alliance). We temporarily expanded our service area. Thus, 2020 was the first time since the Alliance began that the Pantry distributed more food (137,165# in the Pantry).



Pantry Service (Total Assistance)

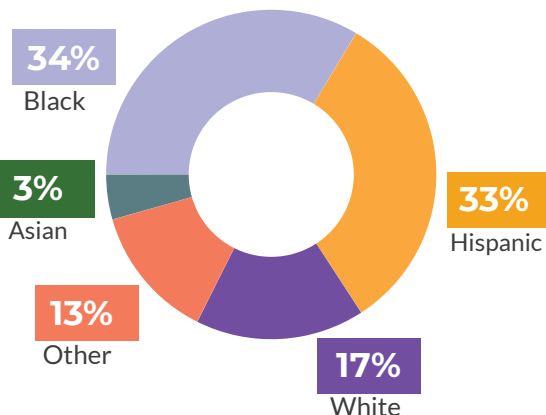


COVID-19 Impact

The pandemic brought significant changes to our operation. The number of people we assisted **more than doubled**. Almost 40% were **first-time** visitors. The Hispanic community was especially hard-hit. We served **775% more Hispanic neighbors** than the prior year.

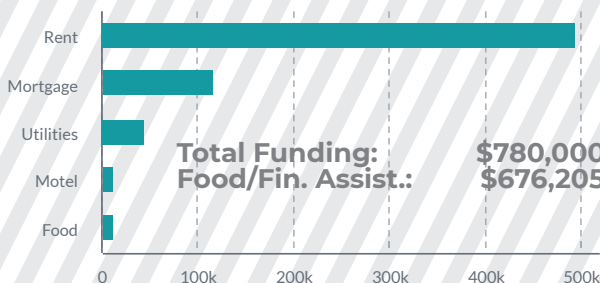

Invited to partner with the City of Tucker, we temporarily expanded our operation to distribute federal funds through the CARES Act.
